1 *Abstract*—These instructions show by example how to pre-  
 2 pare your *two page* abstract which will be published on the web-  
 3 site prior to the workshop. You will need to submit your paper  
 4 as Word, Postscript or Adobe Acrobat PDF format file via email  
 5 ([info@cca08.com](mailto:info@cca08.com)). All submissions must be formatted for US  
 6 Letter 8.5 inches (21.59 cm) in X 11 inches (27.94 cm) page size.  
 7 Only electronic submissions will be accepted.

## I. INTRODUCTION

11 A. Second

12 Follow the type sizes specified in Table I as best you can.  
 13 Use a proportional, serif typeface such as Times or Dutch  
 14 Roman. Avoid sans serif typefaces such as Swiss or Helve-  
 15 tica. If your paper is longer than 2 pages, you may shorten it  
 16 by using a slightly smaller type size for the main text.

18 1) *Third level heading Format*: In formatting your 8.5 in.  
 19 X 11 in. page, set the top margin to 1 in. and the bottom mar-  
 20 gin to .83 in. Set the left and right margins to 0.7 in. This  
 21 gives a column length of 9.122 in. The column width is 3.456  
 22 in. The space between the two columns is 0.100 in. Paragraph  
 23 indentation is about .14 in.  
 24 Don't use any page numbers.

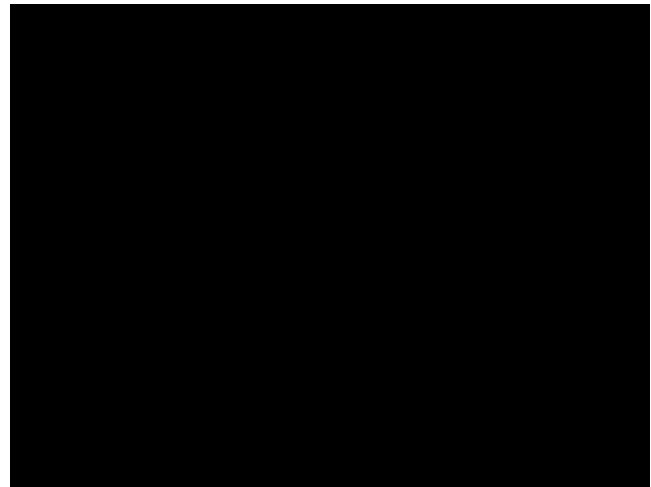


Fig. 1. This line is the figure subtitle.
